	<p>A set is the time that a musician or band plays to an audience at a gig.</p>
	<p>When it is your turn to play your set, Robyn will introduce you to the audience. The audience will clap and you can come on stage and start playing. If you prefer Flappause (when people flap instead of clapping) please let us know.</p>
	<p>When your set time is finished Robyn will stand at the side of the stage area.</p>
	<p>If you do not stop playing Robyn will try to make eye contact with you and wave at you. Please let us know if you would prefer Robyn to let you know in a different way that your set needs to finish.</p>
	<p>If you still don't stop playing Robyn will gently touch your shoulder (unless you would prefer her to let you know in another way that your set needs to finish).</p>
	<p>Please know nobody is angry or upset with you. When you are really enjoying playing music sometimes you are not aware of time.</p>
	<p>Please let us know if you want to take your equipment off the stage straight away, so that we can make sure there is enough time in the timetable for you to do this.</p>
