










## Soundcheck, social story.

	<p>A soundcheck is when a musician or band make sure all their equipment is working and they have the sound they want before they play their music to the audience. Soundchecks normally happen before the audience arrive.</p>
	<p>You can eat before or after your soundcheck. <b>Make sure you are ready to soundcheck at your scheduled time</b>, you can bring food into Café OTO before the gig.</p>
	<p>Set up as much of your equipment off the stage as you can (to take onto the stage) before your sound check - please try to do this quietly.</p>
	<p>Soundcheck's are 30 minutes for each musician/band. Sometimes a band might have a technical. Issue and this might mean soundchecks do not run to schedule. Please let us know, how best to communicate this information to you.</p>
	<p>When your soundcheck time is up, Rosie or Shaun will tell you.</p>
	<p>If you don't stop playing Robyn will come and tap you on the shoulder. (if you prefer another way for Robyn to let you know it's time to stop, please let us know.)</p>
	<p>Please keep out of the stage area while other bands/musicians soundcheck.</p>
